1 Consult & Execute BAA Update SOPs, schedule an on-site assessment, and sign a BAA with a NAID AAA certified vendor.	2 Secure Collection Set up routine pickups with uniformed, badge-carrying teams and marked vehicles.	3 Data Destruction Sanitize devices to NIST 800-88 standards — verified overwrite or physical shredding.	4 Downstream Tracking Require audit-ready tracking through R2v3-certified recycling partners.	5 Document & Certify Collect Certificates of Destruction and Sanitization as your audit trail.
